Scrutiny of EU withdrawal arrangements

Thank you for your letter of 24 September 2020 in which you ask whether it would be appropriate to work together on EU withdrawal arrangements.

Following an initial scrutiny session on 21 September, we have arranged to take further evidence from the Counsel General, Jeremy Miles MS, on the UK Government's United Kingdom Internal Market Bill at 10.00am on 2 November 2020.

Given that clauses 46 and 47 of the Bill concern powers for UK Ministers which could potentially impact on the Welsh financial settlement and accordingly the effectiveness of how devolution operates, we would like to invite you and a member of your Committee to attend our session with the Counsel General on 2 November. We are also extending an invitation to the External Affairs and Additional Legislation Committee.
