

UK-EU relations: the responsibilities of Welsh Ministers

UK-EU relations are mainly governed by two key treaties:

The Withdrawal Agreement sets the terms for the UK's withdrawal from the EU.

The Trade and Cooperation Agreement sets up their new relationship.

Both treaties contain devolved matters, for which the Welsh Government is responsible for implementing, such as fisheries, health, the economy and the environment. Our infographic shows each Minister and where their responsibilities intersect with the main parts of the Trade and Cooperation Agreement (TCA) and/or Withdrawal Agreement (WA).
