I have today published a [progress update on the Welsh Government's Well-being of Future Generations Continuous Learning and Improvement Plan 2023-25](#).

The Plan set out a range of actions and ongoing activities designed to deepen the understanding and application of the sustainable development principle in the Welsh Government. The Plan was informed by the Section 20 review carried out by the former Future Generations Commissioner for Wales in 2022 and delivers on the recommendation from the review.

In June 2023, the former Minister for Social Justice and Chief Whip, wrote to you explaining we will use our annual progress reporting on the Plan to continue to communicate the progress we are making to implement the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 and we would ensure you are notified when the annual progress updates are published.

I am pleased to report we continue to make progress and are making the necessary improvements to how the Welsh Government works. The Progress Update provides an overview of the lessons we have learnt so far and highlights resources which can help the public bodies and others who are using the well-being of future generations approach to organise and change how they work.
