Dear Mike,

Thank you for your letter dated 5 June 2024 asking for an update on my progress in bringing forward healthy food environment legislation this year.

I can confirm that I intend to lay legislation to restrict the price promotion and placement of high fat, salt and sugar products before the Senedd in 2024. I will very shortly be consulting on the text of draft regulations and an enforcement approach for this legislation. The restrictions and proposed enforcement approach largely mirror UK Government regulations in this area.

My officials are in regular contact with teams in UK Government to discuss the proposals I intend to take forward. This has included ongoing discussions around the impact of the Internal Market Act 2020. I will update you on the conclusions of our assessment in relation to this in due course.

To respond to your final question, the announcement of the UK General Election has resulted in a pause to the UK Government's programme of revoke, restate and reform using its Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 powers. Until the results of the Election and an announcement on the new government's projected use of REUL powers, we cannot say what effect they will have on our proposals.
