## Finance Committee Report: Fiscal Intergovernmental Relations

I would like to welcome you to your new role as Chair of the Treasury Committee. Earlier this year, the Interparliamentary Finance Committee Forum (IFCF) met informally with Members of the Treasury Committee at Westminster to discuss issues of common interest, which we found extremely beneficial.

I would therefore like to make you aware that the Finance Committee of the Senedd has conducted an inquiry on [Fiscal Intergovernmental Relations \(IGR\)](#) and published a [report](#). Taken together, our conclusions and recommendations provide a set of principles and examples of good practice on how IGR on fiscal matters can be improved.

Fiscal devolution has led to budgetary decisions in the UK and devolve nations becoming more closely linked. Given your Committee's remit and our mutual interest in these matters, you may be interested in our reports' findings and I hope that there might be an opportunity for future joint working in scrutinising the UK Government on these matters.

The Committee will hold a Plenary debate on the report, provisionally scheduled for 11 December, and will be available to watch via [Senedd.TV](#), and we would welcome any further correspondence you have on this matter.
