Finance Committee Report: Scrutiny of the Welsh Government Draft Budget 2026-27

As you will be aware, we have been undertaking scrutiny of the Welsh Government Draft Budget 2026-27. We would like to thank you once again for giving oral evidence on 1 December to inform our work.

Enclosed with this letter is a copy of the Committee's **report** which was laid on 15 December 2025. We wish to draw your attention to the following recommendation which relates to the work of the Office for Budget Responsibility (**recommendation 7**):

Recommendation 7 'The Committee recommends that the Office for Budget Responsibility continues to produce and develop outputs that help foster understanding of the impact of devolved taxation on the Welsh Government's budgets, such as the analysis of changes in the Welsh net tax position published as part of this year's devolved tax and spending forecasts.'
