As you are aware the Children, Young People and Education (CYPE) Committee is committed to monitoring the progress of the implementation of the new curriculum. As part of this the Committee has recently issued a consultation seeking the views of those involved, and/or with a particular interest, in the work being undertaken to develop and design the new curriculum. On Thursday 10 January 2019 the Cabinet Secretary for Education has agreed to attend a Committee meeting to update the Committee on her progress on curriculum reform. This will also be an opportunity for Members to raise any concerns from stakeholders. This meeting will be in public and you will be able to view the session on [Sendd TV](#).

You may also be aware that the Culture, Welsh Language and Communications (CWLC) Committee recently undertook a poll asking people to vote on the topic for their next inquiry. It was recently announced that the topic that won was 'Teaching of Welsh history, culture and heritage', The CWLC Committee will be launching a consultation shortly in relation to that inquiry and would very much welcome a submission from yourselves. The CYPE Committee hope the findings from that inquiry will help inform its own work on curriculum reform.
