Inter-Institutional relations agreement

Thank you for your recent letters regarding your attendance at the JMC (European Negotiations) and the JMC (Europe) on 9 May and 13 June 2019 respectively. The Committee welcomes these notifications, and acknowledges them in respect of the Inter-Institutional relations agreement (IIRA).

We note, however, that in both letters of notification you write that you will report to the Committee on the outcome of the meetings, and that we have yet to receive any further update. More broadly, while we have also received a number of letters from your Welsh Government colleagues notifying us of forthcoming meetings (relevant to the scope of the IIRA), we have not subsequently received written summaries of those meetings. We acknowledge that the Welsh Ministers have issued some written statements to all Assembly Members following these meetings. However, paragraph 14 of the IIRA provides that the Welsh Government:

“will provide the CLA Committee and any other relevant committee of the National Assembly with a written summary of the issues discussed at the meeting as soon as practicable and, if possible, within two weeks.”

We would therefore be grateful to receive written summaries of the relevant meetings you and the Welsh Ministers have attended, at the earliest convenience.

Finally, we would like to thank you for your letter of 3 July 2019 regarding the ongoing discussions on the Intergovernmental Relations Review and Common



Frameworks. We welcome this update in relation to the Welsh Government's joint work with other UK governments.
