Dear Llyr

I am writing to advise the Committee that I will be proposing an amendment to the second supplementary budget motion to correct an administrative error in respect of the accruing resources for the Wales Audit Office.

The supplementary budget motion laid on 4<sup>th</sup> February proposes that the accruing resources for the Wales Audit Office is increased by £350k to £14,825k (Part 3 of Schedule 4). This amount has been overstated by £50k. Accordingly, I am proposing an amendment to reduce the accruing resources to £14,775k which reflects the amount set out in the Wales Audit Office's Explanatory Memorandum submitted to the Committee in January.

I apologise for this oversight. I trust the Committee will be able to consider this amendment as part of its scrutiny of the second supplementary budget.
